

2016 KS2 SATs Results Summary

The 2016 KS2 assessments are the first which assess the new, more challenging national curriculum which was introduced in 2014. New tests and interim frameworks for teacher assessment have been introduced to reflect the revised curriculum.

Results are no longer reported as levels, and each pupil will now receive their test results as a scaled score and teacher assessments based on the standards in the interim framework.

33% of Cheetham pupils reached the new expected standard in **reading, writing and mathematics.**

53% of pupils nationally reached the new expected standard in **reading, writing and mathematics.**

The children were awarded a scaled score for each KS2 test. The scaled score range runs from 80 to 120 with 100 as the expected standard.

Progress Measure: KS1 to KS2

The new progress measures aim to capture the progress that pupils make from the end of KS1 to the end of Primary School. They are a type of value added measure, which means that pupils' results are compared to the actual achievement of other pupils nationally with similar prior attainment.
